SUBJECT: On-Campus Housing – 2014/2015

Congratulations on your acceptance to Widener University School of Law. A limited number of single occupancy dormitory rooms are available on the Delaware campus. The rooms are furnished with an extra long twin bed, a dresser, a wardrobe, a file drawer, two bookshelves, a table, and a chair. Each room also includes a refrigerator, microwave, internet access, cable television hook up and heating/air conditioning unit. Bathroom facilities are shared by the residents on each wing. Kitchen and laundry facilities are shared as well.

The 2014-2015 cost for a dormitory room will be \$ 5,254, payable in two equal installments of \$ 2,627. A non-refundable deposit of \$ 300 is required to reserve a dormitory room. When you move into your room, your \$ 300 deposit will be applied toward your housing charges. **If you do not reside on campus after making a room reservation, your \$ 300 deposit will be forfeited to the law school – no exceptions.** If you would like to reserve a dormitory room, please return the Housing Reservation Form and non-refundable deposit to the Office of Campus Services. Your room assignment, mailing address and arrival date will be sent to you by the end of July.

The University offers Wellness Halls as part of dormitory housing. The rooms are for residents who choose to commit to a healthy lifestyle. The number of rooms available are limited and will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. Residents are required to sign an agreement to live within specific parameters regarding the use of prohibited substances. The Wellness Hall agreement can be viewed online with the housing information.

The University requires all students living on campus carry health insurance. The University has also implemented a drug-free policy and requires all students to adhere to the parameters set forth within. Inquiries concerning these policies should be directed to the Office of Student Affairs.

In order to promote a healthy environment, Widener University is tobacco free. The use of any tobacco product is prohibited within university buildings and outdoor areas on campus.
