### What is CALI?

CALI, the Center for Computer-Assisted Legal Instruction, publishes over 300 computer-based tutorials in 28 legal subject areas. Written by law faculty and law librarians, these interactive lessons use a variety of methods for teaching doctrine, analysis and critical thinking skills. The lessons are regularly reviewed and revised, and can be helpful in testing your understanding of an area of law.

### Accessing CALI Lessons

CALI is available over the Internet at **[www.cali.org](http://www.cali.org)**. Access to CALI Lessons is limited to members of the Widener University Law School community. The first time you log on as a user, you will need to register. To do so, you will need the authorization code for the either the Delaware or Harrisburg campus which is available at the Reference Desk.

When registering, you will select your own password. If you forget your password, click on the forgotten password link on the CALI webpage and your password will be emailed to you.

Click on **Lessons** and select the subject area in which you are interested. Once in a subject area, you will be able to choose from among the many lesson topics described. Decide on a lesson and click on the version you want to use.

### CALI CD

CALI CD's are made available to all incoming students. The CALI CD contains the same material as the CALI website. But they can be useful when you don't have Internet access.

### CALI Radio

CALI.org has also begun hosting podcasts which are downloadable audio files on legal education topics. These audio files can be downloaded and transferred to an mp3 device like an Ipod. They can also be played on most computers that have a free MP3 player such as Windows Media Player.
