Minor Myers is an associate professor of law at Brooklyn Law School. He teaches courses on corporate law, mergers and acquisitions, corporate finance, and property. His scholarship focuses on corporate governance, shareholder litigation, executive compensation, and corporate director behavior. He has presented his research at the American Law & Economics Association, the Conference on Empirical Legal Studies, the Canadian Law and Economics Association, and the European Law & Economics. His work has been selected for the Harvard/Stanford/Yale Junior Faculty Forum and the NYU/Penn Conference on Law & Finance. He and his research have appeared in the *New York Times*, *Washington Post*, *Wall Street Journal*, and the *Financial Times*, among other publications. His paper on multi-forum shareholder litigation is forthcoming in the *University of Illinois Law Review*, and his past work has appeared in the *Delaware Journal of Corporate Law*, *Indiana Law Journal*, and others. He previously practiced in the corporate and litigation departments of Debevoise & Plimpton in New York. He also clerked for Judge Peter W. Hall and then Judge Ralph K. Winter of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit.
