EXAMSOFT INFORMATION

ExamSoft is a company that supplies software called SofTest that permits you to take your final examinations using your own laptop. SofTest blocks access to your hard drive and all other applications while you are taking your examination. If you choose to use SofTest, you must provide your own laptop and power cord (the laptop battery is not enough). We will print your completed examinations and deliver to your professors.

NOTE

Because the majority of our students are using ExamSoft, you will be automatically registered for ExamSoft. The cost is \$60.00 for the academic year (\$30.00 FALL/\$30.00SPRING). If you do not wish to use ExamSoft and would rather write your exams, you will need to come to the Registrar's Office by November 18th to have the amount credited to your account.

- An estimated 80,000,000 Hershey's Kisses are wrapped each day, using enough aluminum foil to cover over 50 acres of space that's almost 40 foot ball fields. All that foil is recyclable, but not many people realize it.
